Old Business

- 1) Approval of February Meeting minutes Tabled due to them just having been sent out that afternoon
- 2) Mural update/Review:
 - a) PEC Meeting Feb 28th: Concept overall approved, Install date of April likely delayed due to agreement needed to be signed protecting against damages/graffiti, permit completed, Green Star insurance expiring. Also, need CPD present for install, need to consider photo liability *Insurance issue solved, Cynthia (last name) to be present during the install (unsure how this will work), waiting on John Gay for signed agreement*

II. New Business

- 1) Park Advocacy Conference, Park Security Summit Feedback Seed Grant awarded to CPAC, however wasn't given at conference and unsure of the amount should be in the mail, CPD has initiative to get teens involved more into system, overall, security summit, many parks have the same issues, and are asking for better lighting, etc., survey on lighting can be done, see Supervisor updates, also push from CPD to get gardening and kids involved in this, making sure kids understand where veggies come from, etc.. Some things learned from other parks: use newsletters to get more / arrange for volunteers, councils did share issues, talk about coming to visit other parks. Note, if you want a special event permit, it needs to be pulled 60 days prior to event.
- 2) Supervisor update: A teen of the park (need name) made it to citywide for the outstanding teen award, teen made it to the last round, but didn't win, very proud of her! New rec leader is on board, park for the first time is fully staffed. New rec leader (Sidale sp?) will focus on Park Kids, and Saturday Sports, kids, girls and boys are taking to her. Soccer has advanced to regional play, lots of wins for our sports groups, need to get photos and notices on the website. CP has very strong staff participation in comparison to other parks in terms of taking advantage of the overall PD events that are out there. Spring Camp need more kids, only ~7 registered, can take at least 20 more, try to get the word out to schools, there will be two field trips, one to WP for a movie and to the Nature center
 - a) Highlights from Feb 20 Meeting:
 - i) volunteer applications need to be redone with a copy of driver's license
 - ii) April 1st is the deadline for the summer Movies in the park application
 - iii) Block Party: 2 inflatables from our area, maybe a dunk tank available
 - iv) Future: a movie projector can be borrowed
 - v) Feb. 25 coaches clinic cancelled / postponed until March TBD
 - vi) Earth Day hours needed
- 3) Friends of the Park / Pocket Park Update: Note: there is an overall move to get parks from the rubberized surface to mulch. Snowberry as well as the others need mulch to fill in troughs that have been carved out under the swings, e.g., Alderman to be contacted for the playground refresh Playground Replacement Program for all three parks. 50 signatures needed for each park, need to get that out during Easter Hunt and Earth Day petition at events
 - a) Snowberry Update: Applied for a new grant due to the fact that ComEd was not offering the Parkways grant again if grant received Cathy was open to sharing goods with Commercial Park. New schedule

for Green Growers – Ronda to add in the Commercial Park dates alongside the schedule, new plantings will be needed, as well as a soil refresh,

- b) Superior Update
 - i) Playground replacement program looking to replace ashphalt at gate with pavers, however a budget needs to be established to do this. The neighbors around Superior really like the state of the park and don't see too much improvement needed on park, like that is has an "adventure quality to it. The growth, old growth, has become so substantial, they are looking for someone who can, with knowledge, say what and how something needs to be trimmed, cut back, equipment, Levar, Georgia and Shandrel to work with Levar (?)

 - i) Playground replacement program Jeanne to handle signatures and get forms in
- 4) Commercial Park update: Overall Gardens, need more volunteers for not only Green Growers, but just to assist on what needs to be done to existing gardens and bushes, etc.

The following are the discussion points from the meeting to discuss the Mural development:

Current Situation:

Discussion Points:

- Design for Rice side: For the most part all agreed on design, noted that the sports needed to switch "quadrants" to better represent logical fit of sport to season:
